The Healing of Naaman

Since disease entered our world through sin, God has been healing people. I believe this will continue until the restoration of all things foretold in Revelation.

Naaman is healed some 800 years before Jesus Christ.

His response: 'Now I know that there is no God in all the world except in Israel'. When God heals, he is glorified and people are encouraged into faith, faith in the one true God.

Francis MacNutt believes that God heals today but suggests twelve reasons why people are sometimes not healed:

- 1) Lack of Faith (this has got to be the main reason)
- 2) Redemptive Suffering (our physical healing is not God's highest want for us).
- 3) A false value attached to suffering.
- 4) Sin which has not been dealt with.
- 5) Not praying specifically.
- 6) Faulty Diagnosis.
- 7) Refusal to see medicine as a way God heals.
- 8) Not using natural means to preserve health.

- 9) Now is not the time.
- 10) A different person is to be the instrument of healing.
- 11) The social environment prevents healing from taking place.
- 12) Demonic interference.

Brothers and sisters, I encourage you to continue to pray for healing. We worship a God of compassion and love who delights in healing people today.
